Committee News

Following the public meeting in early January the Committee has held it's first formal committee meeting and new members have joined. The committee meeting has enabled sub-groups to be formed to deal with many different aspects of the planning which is a necessary evil before actual work can begin on the refurbishment of the hall. These groups will look into the management of the hall and the legal issues which may arise; they'll promote the use of the hall; fundraise, including finding out more about grant funding; they'll plan the public consultation; and will plan the maintenance and possible refurbishment of the hall.

The committee would like to redevelop the Hall. They feel this building is a community asset ... BUT ... the experience of other similar small community halls shows that this can only succeed if lots of people get involved in the process. We need not just to maximise the use of the hall but also to use common sense to solve the inevitable problems that will arise. One starting point is to agree on a design for the Small Hall.

To that end the hall will be open on the evenings of Monday 15th, Tuesday 16th and Friday 19th March for folk to come along and

sketch their vision and/or to write down their ideas for uses for the Hall. This will give the committee a clearer idea of what the community want before we approach professionals to develop our ideas.

Other Events

There are plans afoot for many other events in the coming months, here are a few ideas.
