A survey has been distributed throughout the parish. The results of this survey will give a far clearer indication of how to proceed with the Hall redevelopment. The Constitution of the Public Hall Association and Trust Deed of the Welfare Trust are to be reviewed as these documents have been highlighted as the main reason why the latest funding application has not been granted.
