Public Entertainment Licensing

The Public Entertainment Licensing system has been under review and is being extended so that the whole of the Aberdeenshire Council area is subject to the same requirements. Such licenses will be required for the use of premises and for events where an admission charge is made. The Council has arranged two briefing sessions on the application procedures aimed at providing information to bodies that will be required to apply for licenses. The forms will be available at the briefing sessions or by post.

Logie Coldstone's representatives on the Cromar Community Council (CCC) are Jerry Tyson (Auld Kirk), who is currently the CCC treasurer, and Evelyn Smith (Smith's Garage).

A large number of residents have asked for better communications with the CCC. Meeting dates are published with the minutes posted on the notice board outside the Airedale Lounge, and the meetings are open to the public. However, here are a few pointers to topics discussed relevant to Logie Coldstone in this newsletter.

- There is a Scottish Executive initiative to place 20 mph speed limits outside all Scottish schools – we'll be getting signs sometime soon.
- Safe access to the school (gates, parking, and pavements) was raised with our local county councillor.
- The dog warden is considering a litter bin at Sunnybrae.
- Neighbourhood watch schemes were discussed – is there interest in Logie Coldstone for such a scheme? Let us know.
- Although there is a 'porous' boundary with the Cairngorm National Park for most things, for planning purposes a hard line has been drawn. This will have an impact on our community.
- Another wheelie bin (blue top) is due in the New Year – for papers and light card.

We were delighted to welcome Mrs Andrea Hauxwell to a meeting of trustees and committee on 18/11/05. Andrea is employed by K&D Voice, which is the Kincardine and Deeside branch of the Council for Voluntary Services and whose role is to support and develop voluntary groups in this area. Andrea helped us begin the process of reviewing the constitution of the Public Hall Association with the current Committee and Trustees to bring it up to date and more in line with our activities. This process will now be carried forward by a working group.

Meanwhile, grant funding is to be applied for to allow us get the necessary legal advice to review the Declaration of Trust of 1967 to bring it also up to date and in line with our activities.

Further changes to the overall legal structure may be deemed necessary once we are further along with the feasibility study but at the moment, however, we take one step at a time.
