The Welfare Trust was formed in 1967 to:-

(Extract from the declaration of trust)

- take over the Logie Coldstone Hall and site on which it is erected, together with all fixtures and fittings therein and any funds from the trustees for the Public Hall of Logie Coldstone Parish.
- equip and maintain on the said site a hall to be known as Logie Coldstone Hall with a view to providing improved amenities and facilities for the public, so that the hall may be run in the manner most beneficial to the Community and available to provide facilities for charitable or educational projects as deemed advisable including without prejudice to said generality, physical and mental training and recreation, and social, moral and intellectual development through the medium of recreation rooms, library, lectures, classes, recreation or otherwise as may be found expedient for the inhabitants of the district without distinction of sex or political, religious or other opinions.
- receive subscriptions, contributions, donations, gifts, legacies and all accessions of every kind.
- encourage the development of youth welfare in the District.

Logie Coldstone Public Hall Association has as its objects:-

(extract from Association Constitution)

Objects:

- To implement the conditions of the Deed of Trust dated July and August 1967
- To promote the well being of the inhabitants of Logie Coldstone and district by associating the local authorities, voluntary organisations and residents in a common effort to promote social activities, to foster community spirit and to advance education.
- To maintain and manage the Logie Coldstone Public Hall for activities promoted by the association and its constituent bodies in the furtherance of the above objects, and to carry out any extension of the premises or facilities provided which may at any time seem necessary or desirable.
- The Association shall be non party political and non sectarian.

Membership: -

As can be read in the Association Constitution ” membership of the association shall be open to all persons over the age of eighteen resident in the district.”
