## What's Happening with the Hall

### **LOGIE COLDSTONE PUBLIC HALL ASSOCIATION AGM**

The last AGM of this Association is planned for 1<sup>st</sup> June 2007 at 19:30hrs at Logie Coldstone Hall. The Association and the Logie

Coldstone Welfare Trust will then be dissolved and the new Logie Coldstone Trust (a Company Limited by Guarantee with Charitable Status) will take over.

**The aims of the Company** are detailed in the new Memorandum and Articles as the following:-

**A.** *The objects for which the Company is established are the advancement of citizenship and community development by the promotion of the well being of the inhabitants of Logie Coldstone and District, by associating the local authorities, voluntary organisations and residents in a common effort to promote social activities and to foster community spirit.*

**B.** *In furtherance of its objects the Company will undertake the following particular activities:- the maintenance and management of the Logie Coldstone Public Hall for activities promoted by the Company and its constituent bodies and to carry out any extension of the premises or facilities provided which may at any time seem necessary or desirable.*

### **Membership and nominations for the committee**

Individuals over the age of eighteen and resident in the Polling District of Logie Coldstone who support the aims of the Company are eligible for membership of the new Logie Coldstone Trust and may also wish to be nominated for election as a director, since there are a few vacancies.
